ToT Course on UN Comprehensive Protection of Civilians for Military– 15 Aug 2022

Aim and Objectives:

The aim of the ToT course is to familiarize military peacekeeping trainers with the Reinforcement Training Package on UN Comprehensive Protection of Civilians for Military (CPOC-M) in order to enable them to deliver the same course to the future peacekeepers. The objectives of the course include:

- Enhance facilitation skills among participants;
- Enable participants to deliver RTP UN CPOC-M;
- Assess the participants on their delivery skills to be considered as international trainer in ITS Roster;
- To Enable direct interaction between participants and trainers from ITS;

Target Audience:

Member State National trainers who are qualified instructors; should be of the rank of Captain to Lieutenant Colonel or equivalent; be either currently employed as a peacekeeping training instructor or will be employed for such functions in near future; should have a good command over English language; experienced in UN peacekeeping missions is an added advantage.
