Women's Military Peace Operations Course (WMPOC)

Aim and Objectives: The aim of this course is to increase women's full, equal, and meaningful participation in United Nations (UN) Peace Operations, in accordance with UN Security Council resolution 2242 (2015) and the UN Uniformed Gender Parity Strategy 2018-2028. The primary focus of the course will be to:

- Meaningfully engage military women and foster their development
- Prepare them for deployment to UN Peace Operations

The ToT will also give participants the opportunity to improve their training delivery skills and enable direct interaction with personnel from UN Women, ITS and other Member States.

Target Audience:

Women military officers from any arm in the rank of Captain to Lieutenant Colonel or equivalent; identified by their Member State to be nominated for deployment or already accepted by the UN DPO Force Generation Service (FGS) to deploy to UN Peace Operations, or identified for employment at a national training centre which leads peacekeeper pre-deployment training; should have a good command of English Language.
