Women military officers from different services in the rank of Captain to Lieutenant Colonel or equivalent; aged between 25 and 55 years old; identified by their Member State to be nominated for deployment or already accepted by the UN DPO Force Generation Service (FGS) to deploy to UN Peace Operations, or identified for employment at a national training center which leads peacekeeper pre-deployment training; should have a good command of English Language; No prior UN Peace Operations experience is required.
