





- Principal UN organisation mandated to promote and protect HR for all
- Focuses on three main areas: standard setting, monitoring, and implementation of HR
- Secretariat for other components of UN HR system
- Lead office for the HR screening policy
- Conduct HR violations inquiries

Responsibilities at Strategic Level

USG DPPA

- Monitors and assesses global political developments
- Guides Special Political Missions and promotes peace/peacebuilding
- Provides staff support to UN Security Council

USG DPO

- Plans, monitors and guides UN Peacekeeping Missions
- Generates / recruits uniformed personnel, units and capabilities
- Liaises with Member States and agencies

USG DMSPC

- Establishes strategic management and policy framework
- Provides strategic human resources guidance and policy
- Manages UN Peace Operations financial matters

USG DOS

- Provides strategic direction to PO support (SPMs & PKMs)
- Delivers dedicated support to UNHQ, entities and field missions
- Provides operational information and communications support

USG DSS

- Provides safety and security framework
- Assumes accountability & responsibility for security direction and control

- Created in 1945 through the UN Charter, the UN Secretariat is located in New York, with offices and agencies worldwide
- The Secretariat supports the UN legislative bodies

- Led by a Secretary-General appointed by the GA
