
2.2.1 IED Threat System

IED System

What is Counter-IED?

The collective efforts to defeat the **IED System** in order to reduce the effect of IEDs on our ability to conduct Missions.





Main Charge (e.g. Homemade Explosive)

Initiator (e.g. Electrical detonator)




Enhancements (e.g. Metal Shrapnel, Ball bearings)





IED System

- May or may not be structured
- Involves multiple activities
- Requires planning



IED System

Resource and Plan:

- Finance and technical support
- Recruiting and training
- Material collection
- Manufacturing









Execute:

- Transport
- Target location
- Reconnaissance
- Timing









Predict – Intelligence Operations



A product of knowledge / analysis of:

- Terrain
- Weather
- Activities
- Capabilities
- Doctrine
- Enemy / Adversaries
 Intentions

Deter – Kinetic (hard) / Non-Kinetic (soft) Operations

Kinetic (Hard) Activity

- C-IED Ambush Operations
- Targeted Offensive Search
- Strike Operations



Non-Kinetic (Soft) Activity

- PSYOPS
- CIMIC
- Media Operations

- Denying insurgent/terrorist freedom of movement.


1. Reducing the **chance** of an IED strike.


1. Reducing the chance of an IED strike – ECM.

2. Reducing the effect of an IED strike. – Equipment and vehicles










Mitigate

- Understand IED makers TTPs
- Gather forensic intelligence to enable prosecutions (disrupt the networ)
