UN Operational Logistics TOT Course – 13 Feb 2023

Aim and Objectives: The aim of this TOT course is to enable Member States to provide training to their personnel on Peacekeeping Operational Logistics. The training objectives of the course are:

- To train trainers to effectively familiarize, understand and make value judgements on the utilisation of the various logistic capabilities provided or needed.
- To assess participants on their delivery skills to a class on the UN policies directing the employment of logistic support and the respective command and control elements of various assets and capabilities, in order to manage logistic capabilities appropriately.
- To enable direct interaction between participants and trainers from ITS & Member States.

Target Audience:

The target audience for this course should comprise logistics trainers, planners and commanders who are or yet to be deployed as trainers in their national PDT center. In order to be selected for this training, participant should: be employed as a trainer and possess a United Nations Staff Officer Course (UNSOC) or national basic military staff course or its equivalent, be military officers of the rank of Captain to Lieutenant-Colonel or police officers of equivalent rank.
