Peacekeeping-Intelligence, Surveillance & Reconnaissance (PKISR) ToT

Aim and Objectives: The aim of this ToT course is to provide Member States with the capacity to deliver UN-PKISR training to their personnel deploying into UN PKISR-related roles in field missions. The primary focus of the course will be on orientating participants to:

- The fundamentals of PKISR processes and outputs
- The policies and structures that govern all PKISR activity
- How PKISR links into the wider PKI/MPKI cycles to drive operational activity

The ToT will also give participants the opportunity to improve their training delivery skills and enable direct interaction with personnel from OMA, ITS and other Member States.

Target Audience:

Member State military officers; should be of the rank of Captain to Lieutenant Colonel or equivalent; must be a professional military intelligence officer by background, with previous ISR or PKISR experience highly desirable; experience in UN peacekeeping missions is an added advantage; should have a good command of the English language.
