According to a Garland Armed Forces (GAF) officer, who has never dealt with UN elements in the past, reports that the GAF unit controlling the border crossing north-east of DAFARI accepts money from the ENLF to allow the group to take control over it. He also reports that the cost of doing business for the ENLF has increased (NFDK). **REPORT ENDS**



POC Site Report Dafari

UNMMIG Relief, Reintegration and Protection (RRP) section

The Dafari POC site hosts approximately 28,270 IDPs according to biometric registration. IDPs are permitted to leave and return to the POC site as required, but there is a curfew 2100h-0500h daily when the camp gates are closed.

The leader of the Dafari POC Camp Committee is well-respected by most IDPs, largely due to his reputation as a militia commander during Garland's invasion. He has now committed to working peacefully for the betterment of Eastarians. Camp Committee meetings are held at the 'Eries Tukul' on the southeast corner of the POC site. However, recently another member of the Camp Committee, known as 'Nertiti', has been making statements critical of the government and indicating sympathies for the ENLF.

The Dotan minority, which makes up approximately 12% of the camp population, is informally led by Augustus Legge, who has expressed frustration that Dotan concerns are not considered in camp decision-making. Most Dotan IDPs were displaced during the government's counterinsurgency campaigns in North Eri and are generally moderates who tried to protect Eastarians. Many come from the village of Walesi where significant intermarriage has occurred and the Dotans form around 45% of the town. Some Dotans in the POC camp have been critical of the Eastarians due to their perception that Eastarians have assisted members of armed groups by storing weapons within the camp. The Dotans resent the government, particularly the GAF, but do not support Eastarian secession and believe that a deal with the government for increased autonomy is the best way forward. The town of Ganush has no Dotans at all as the Eastarians attacked any settlers who tried to move there, claiming the Dotans were being deliberately settled on their lands to dilute Eastarian influence.

The local Catholic priest is highly respected among the population, including those in the POC camp. He is wary of becoming involved in local politics as he wishes to remain neutral but has been very influential in mediating disputes, and many believe he has back-channel access to the local ENLF and EIMF commanders. He lives in a small dwelling adjacent to the church in the north-east part of Nicada.

The main NGOs operating in the IDP camp are Medecins Sans Frontieres (MSF), Norwegian Refugee Council (NRC) and 7th Continent for Peace (7C4P). They are generally cooperative although are wary of being seen engaging too closely with Force. They often have good information on atmospherics within the POC site. Jawanna Henry is the lead MSF doctor and she is often aware of when there has been fighting in the area as MSF are called to treat the injured. IOM, UNHCR and WFP also have a strong presence in the camp.

The two (2) adults and one child were also reported to be refugees from Northland, who had arrived in the region only recently. The article suggests that the victims were suffering from symptoms (incl. hemorrhaging, fever) that are consistent with a tropical disease with a very high degree of mortality.

ROAD BRIDGE COLLAPSE ON MSR BETWEEN WALESI AND BYRA

At 0630LT a road bridge collapsed on the MSR between WALESI and BYRA with at least 5 civilians (including 3 children) killed.

CIMIC ASSESSMENT: It is assessed that the unusually heavy seasonal rains over the past two weeks have caused streams and rivers to swell and with heavy rainfall moving down from the EASTERN MOUNTAIN RANGE, there is an increased risk of damage (potentially catastrophic) to existing infrastructure. The risk is heightened by the already poor state of repair to most of GARLAND transport infrastructure with road surfaces disintegrating and bridges under threat of being washed away or severely structurally weakened. If this happens it could have an impact on both UNMMIG and civilian FoM. **CIMIC ASSESSMENT ENDS**

If true, this raises the threat towards DAFARI, which, when controlled by the EIMF, could act as a springboard for operations towards the capital NICADA and elsewhere in GARLAND.

SHOTS FIRED AT UNMMIG PATROL BETWEEN NICADA & DAFARI



At approximately 1900hrs on the 28 Nov 18 Patrol ALPHA reported that shots were fired at the patrol at the road Junction (GR 222 264) on the road from NICADA to DAFARI. Two bursts of small arms fire (approx. 10-12 rds) were reported to have been fired at the patrol from SOUTHEAST of the Junction. It was further reported that two armed civilians were seen leaving the area of the shooting on a motorbike

and heading SOUTH towards the border area.

The patrol carried out anti-ambush drills and drove through the area and RV'd at a safe location. They observed the movement out of the location and noted that the two-armed civilians left the scene on a blue TRIUMPH MOTORCYCLE. This is the first time an UNMMIG Patrol has been fired at and attacked.



On 29 Nov 18 an UNMMIG UAS reported a man-made obstacle blocking the road NORTH of TURUS. The obstacle appeared to consist of old donkey carts and wooden pallets with tree branches and old vehicle tyres. The obstacle blocked the road completely denying Freedom of Movement (FOM) NORTH and SOUTH along this route.

An UNMMIG patrol (Patrol BRAVO) was dispatched to the area to investigate the report and observed that there were a total of four (4) unarmed elements IVO of the obstacle with at least one hand-held radio within the group and mobile phones.

UNMMIG Patrol BRAVO reported that the obstacle was contributing to traffic congestion on the Northern side of the obstacle forcing civilians to leave their vehicles and inspect the obstacle. The patrol further reported that the occupants of the vehicles seemed to be angry at the UNMMIG Patrol for not clearing the obstacle and after several minutes angrily gesturing towards the patrol and started to throw stones in the direction of the patrol.

S2 ASSESSMENT (UNC): This is the first time a road-block has been setup on this part of the Sector EAST. It is assessed that it was put in place to extort money from the local population and humanitarian actors and discredit UNMMIG ability to provide Freedom of Movement (FOM) in the sector. **S2 ASSESSMENT ENDS**

The UNMMIG patrol adhered to rules of engagement and, as a result, was prevented from leaving the area for approximately one hour, during which time stones were also thrown at UN vehicles. There were no injuries.

The protestors were waiting for the UNMMIG patrol and it is likely that they had spotters on the road warning them of the UNMMIG approach.
